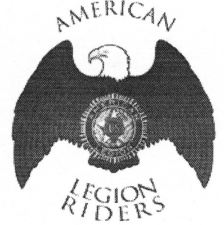

Our members have raised \$1,472.00 to partner with Kevin Lawlor of Jared Jewelry and Jim & Molly Hennley of Phoenix to purchase approximately 150 stuffed animal toys which will be donated to the Phoenix Children's Hospital for their patients to have for comfort during the coming Holiday Season.

On Saturday, December 13th, 2025 at 10:00am, members of the American Legion Riders will arrive at Jared Jewelry where each motorcycle member will receive a "stuffed partner" to ride along as they proceed in a group to the Phoenix Children's Hospital – Arrowhead Campus at 19007 N 67th Ave, Glendale, AZ.

Once there, the American Legion Riders will meet with some of the patients and PCH Staff on the west side of the hospital (subject to change due to weather or other conditions) and provide the children with a stuffed toy.

The "stuffed partners" who did not manage to get a ride on a motorcycle will be transported in vehicles and provided to the PCH Staff to be distributed to future PCH patients and those patients who could not attend the arrival of the parade of motorcycles.
